All tree prices are FOB Manton, Michigan. Freight estimates are available upon request. Freight quotes and rates are subject to Fuel Surcharge, if necessary. Orders may also be picked up at our farm. Dutchman will do everything to ensure your shipment is sent according to your specifications. Inclement weather may delay some shipments.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. A TAX ID# or Nursery License is required to order.
2. Fall orders must be received by September 1st.
Spring orders must be received by March 1st.
3. Net 30 days to customers with established credit history.
4. New accounts must pre-pay in full until credit is established.
5. A finance charge of 1.5% (annual rate of 18%) will be charged on all delinquent accounts over 30 days.
6. To ensure orders, a 25% deposit is required by September 1st for Fall orders, March 1st for Spring orders.
7. A service fee of 3% will be added to all credit card payments.
8. All orders are subject to prior sale, crop injury, availability or loss beyond our control.

ORDER MINIMUMS

- \$500 minimum for customer pick up
- \$2000 minimum for delivery
- 5 tree minimum per species for
Balled and Burlap trees under 10ft
- 4 pallet minimum with 1 species
per pallet for Fiber Potted trees
