

PLANTING A SEEDLING GUIDE

Choose the Right Spot:

Dig

Make a hole only as deep as plug's root ball and only slightly bigger than the width.



Plant

Place plug in hole, ensuring top of root ball is level with soil.



Pat

Carefully tuck soil around roots, patting gently to remove air pockets.

Water Carefully:

- Water the seedling immediately after planting to help settle the soil around the roots.
- Ensure the soil remains consistently moist but not waterlogged. Avoid overwatering, as it can lead to root rot.
